Conditional on the edificial upraising of 15%, exhibitors will now find a larger range of labels and products.


The small patio, which until now was left out, will provide another catering station adjusted with some lounge elements.


The streetparcour, placed in the larger patio as in summer 2006, will show off with some new elements.

Photography Welfare Exhibition


In this selection of images, we wish to show skateboarders styles, the way they dress and look, through the decades, and try to represent every tendency, constant or not, that skaters are endorsing.
